Thank you for your interest in volunteering with BRAWA. Volunteering is a wonderful way to help animals, make new friends, get a little exercise, and support the work of BRAWA.

Volunteers must be at least 16 years of age*, be able to work independently, attend an orientation session, and be willing to commit to a minimum of 4 hours per month for at least six months.

ORIENTATIONS ARE HELD THE FOURTH SATURDAY OF EACH MONTH (except December) AT 10:00 A.M. At the orientation you will tour the shelter, hear our history and mission, and receive a description of volunteer jobs.

- Cleaning Crew/Groundskeeper
