Charming's second chance

Second Chance Fund provides hope and medical care for victim of neglect

On September 26, animal control brought in a dog who had clearly been severely neglected and mistreated. This sweet boy quickly came to be known as "Charming" as he charms the hearts of all who see him. A GoFundMe was immediately set up online to start raising the funds for Charming's medical treatment that he so desperately needs.

Charming's story spread quickly in the Facebook community as users and donors were captivated by his sweet disposition and inspired by his resilience. The GoFundMe is halfway to its goal with over \$5,400 being raised in just 2.5 weeks. All funds raised are put into BRAWA's Second Chance Fund which is specifically set up for victims of abuse and neglect who come in needing major medical treatment and supportive care.

Charming may not be able to hear and has a long road of recovery ahead of him, but the smile on his face and the hope in his eyes shows how grateful he is for the generosity of animal lovers everywhere who are giving him his second chance.
